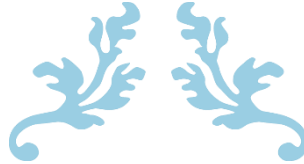

This puppy is guaranteed to be healthy and veterinarian health cleared at the time of sale and at time Adopter takes possession of puppy. The Breeder does not assume any liability for any injury to the puppy after the Adopter takes possession of the puppy or has been released to a pet transporter for delivery of the puppy.

The puppy is guaranteed for 3 years and 10 years for any life-threatening genetic health issues we have tested for in the parents or the puppy will be replaced and/or purchase price refunded at discretion of breeder.

The Adopter agrees to have this puppy examined by a veterinarian within 5 business days of taking possession to assure the Adopter that the puppy is healthy. If the puppy is found to be other than healthy (excluding worms, coccidia, giardia or any other parasites common in puppies) at said veterinary visit, the puppy shall be returned to the Breeder immediately within 3 business days at the adopter



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expense and the purchase price will be refunded or replaced with another puppy as one become available. Written confirmation of life-threatening health concern from the veterinarian is required.

This puppy is purebred and is registerable with limited Registration through the American Kennel Club. limited Registration does not allow breeding and registering offspring as well as being eligible to show in the breed ring. And limited to track and field events and the offspring is not registrable this a family companion pet and for primary use with those that are disabled or in licensed field service need. We recommend having the dog spayed or neutered. The Adopter will be given the application for AKC registration at the time that possession is taken. Temperament, breed ability, and conformation of the puppy are not guaranteed.

The Adopter agrees to maintain the puppy's health in good condition, feed a high-quality food, maintain good weight control, and provide yearly health examinations, vaccinations/titers, heartworm tests and any other usual procedures necessary to assure good health.

The puppy has had appropriate vaccinations for its age and a record of vaccinations, deworming's, and microchip information is supplied to the Adopter.

The Adopter agrees that this puppy will not be sold, or ownership transferred without the Breeder's knowledge and consent. The Adopter will not sell the puppy to a pet shop, Breeder, Laboratory, dog agent, or broker. The Adopter agrees that if at any time proper care cannot be given to the puppy, the Adopter must contact the Breeder. The Breeder will take the puppy back or assist the Adopter in placing the puppy in a suitable home. The breeder will never refuse to have any dog returned at any time.

Every reasonable precaution has been taken to prevent this puppy from acquiring hereditary life threatening diseases including DNA testing and extensive medical testing and OFA Chic testing on parents and /or grandparents that are OFA registerable.

Should this puppy develop Hip Dysplasia (Mild, Moderate, or Severe), Elbow Dysplasia, Subaortic Stenosis, or Cataracts deemed hereditary by 24 months of age, the Breeder will take the puppy back and replace it with a puppy of equal value as soon as available.

Hip and/or Elbow Radiographs must be submitted to and examined by the Orthopedic Foundation for Animals and results must be supplied to the Breeder. Sub-aortic Stenosis must be confirmed by Echocardiography and Doppler performed by a Board-Certified Veterinary Cardiologist and documents must be supplied to the Breeder. Eye exams must be performed by a Board-Certified Veterinary Ophthalmologist and documents must be supplied to the Breeder.



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Environmental factors, like high caloric diet during the rapid growth phase, may exacerbate changes in dysplastic hips or elbows. Therefore, the Breeder refuses to take responsibility for dysplasia in an overweight puppy and thus Adopter will not qualify for a replacement puppy. Veterinarian records must be made available to prove good weight control.

No replacement or refund will be given if the puppy has not been examined by certified veterinarian or AKC certified Veterinarian Hospital within 5 days of receiving puppy.

The Adopter Shall Provide the Dog with:

- Adequate Food, Fresh Water, Shelter, Affection, and proper medical care, which should include an annual health exam and routine vaccinations as recommended by a board-certified veterinarian.
- A fully Fenced Yard or Other humane means of exercise. The dog shall not be continually chained.
- Companionship for the puppy they are like a 2-year-old child and must always have someone with him/her the first few months. And never left alone or out of site.
- Never allow the dog to roam unattended.
- Ample time playing with and talking to your puppy. Golden retrievers thrive on human interaction. Their main goal in life is to please you!
- Proper training and socialize the puppy, visit our web site for training videos to help with proper care of the puppy. The breeder is available at any time by phone or email to help with questions.
- Shall provide a Suprelorin implant this prevents the dog from breeding with out being subjected to surgeries these implants can be taken out for ring and show dogs after full OFA Chic has been performed and full AKC DNA and Genetic health Done. They must remain in place for limited registered dogs.

The Breeder or its representatives will require application for adoption and have access to location the puppy will be housed a 72-hour notice will be given Facetime may be suitable if distance is an issue, background check on the purchaser may be required, references may also be required, home inspections may be required by breeder before or after puppy is taken home, this is to help purchaser with proper environmental concern or issues and care of the puppy needs.

This document represents the entire agreement between the Breeder and the Adopter. No other promises or guarantees are made. The conditions of this agreement may only be changed in writing by mutual consent of both parties.
